\*All residents take Four week-long vacations a year: 1) one week during blocks 1-6; 2) one week during blocks 8-13; and 3) one week during block 7 (holidays/Mega Rounds). The fourth week has been added as of July 1, 2022 for the residents to use during any of the 13 blocks with proper notification.

‡All residents are required to participate in a Performance Improvement (PI) project. Much of this work is done in the PGY-1 year during the PI rotation, but residents still continue to work on their projects throughout the PGY-2 and PGY-3 years. Though no rotation is dedicated to this, however elective time can be used as appropriate. Research is continuous throughout each year.

†Selective rotations for PGY-2s include ID, Neurology, Nephrology, and Endocrinology. PGY-2s generally complete 3 of these during the year but may complete 2 or 4, depending on the rest of their individual schedules. Any remaining selectives are completed during the PGY-3 year. PGY-2s may also complete an away rotation at another institution if they wish.

\*\*Selective rotations for PGY-3s include any not completed during the PGY-2 year (ID, Neurology, Nephrology, or Endocrinology), Rheumatology, Geriatrics, Hematology/Oncology, ER, and Addiction Medicine (listed separately). Once these selectives are scheduled, PGY-3s choose from a list of electives in which they can take two- or four-week rotations and fill up their remaining blocks. This list includes Dermatology, ENT, Allergy/Immunology, Sleep Medicine, Orthopedics, Women's Health/Gynecology, Physical Medicine & Rehab, Hospital Medicine, Psychiatry, Palliative Medicine, Ambulatory Medicine, Radiology, and Pulmonology. PGY-3s also have the option of completing an extra 2-4 weeks of ID, Neurology, Nephrology, or Endocrinology, or an extra 4-week rotation of continuity clinic. Finally, PGY-3s may complete an away rotation at another institution if they wish (if not already taken in the second year).

\*\*\*PGY-3s only complete a GI rotation if one was not completed during the PGY-2 year. If not needed, the resident takes another selective/elective.
